

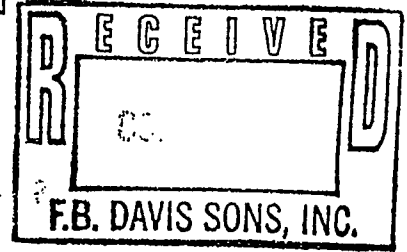

On behalf of the Bangor Area School District, it is my pleasure to thank you for an outstanding job at removing and replacing the metal roof system on the Bangor Area Junior High School this past summer. The existing roof had failed during the past winter, and we were faced with further building damage this coming winter if it were not replaced in an expeditious manner.

Your initial planning efforts in coordinating the roofing contractor, U. S. Roofing; the asbestos abatement contractor, Neuber Environmental; the roofing supplier, Tremco, Inc., and the school district staff proved essential as the project developed over the summer. Your presence was important in helping to coordinate the many aspects of the project that only became apparent as the project evolved.

We were also very impressed with the efforts of U. S. Roofing. It was obvious that their men were top-notch roofing mechanics and, as a result, we have an excellent installation. We often find in capital projects in the school district that our contractors, chosen by low bid, often seek to take short-cuts to maintain profit margins. Not so with U. S. Roofing. Everything that was required to be done, even if it was not part of the original scope of work, was accomplished.


The District has worked with Mr. Alan Benke of Tremco Roof Products in the past, but never on a project of this magnitude. Our Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds, Mr. Alan Ruppert, recommended that the District include the Tremco, tapered to drain cold applied Burmastic system now on our junior high school. He is delighted that for the first time in about twenty years, he and the maintenance staff do not have to worry about the roof leaking at the junior high school. The


About two months have transpired since you completed the rebuilding of Unit I and the repairs of Unit H at the above.
